

Hag Traits

Hags often give themselves titles that imply a family relationship, like "Mother" or "Sister." Anyone who calls a hag by such a title becomes especially vulnerable to the hag's magic.

To determine a hag's name, roll on the Hag Title chart and on the Hag Name chart.

d20 Hag Behavior

- a rare Good Witch
- 2 baking gingerbread men. The gingerbread men are alive and have the stats of skeletons
- 3 churning butter. The butter churn is groaning
- 4 crooning and fondling some ordinary trinket, such as a spoon or a key
- 5 asking you for help against some bully mortal or monster, possibly an enemy of yours. In return, you get a cursed gift
- 6 making a watercolor painting of some famous noble
- 7 eating sweets from a squirming bag
- 8 with an offer of something you'd find valuable in exchange for an unspecified future service
- 9 greets you as royalty and promises you the crown you deserve, if you follow her advice
- greets you by name, describes your recent past, and tells you of your coming doom unless you accept a gift 10
- jarring preserves. Many of the preserved things are ingredients that make it cheaper to make magic items. Others are 11 living monsters such as black puddings
- 12 knitting: the bag of yarn is squirming
- 13 making a pot of tea
- 14 plotting and cackling
- 15 running a bath of blood
- 16 sharpening her teeth on a millstone
- 17 speaking to her mirror
- 18 sweeping with her broom of flying
- 19 feeding her pets
- 20 with a human child: kidnapped? Or a young witch? Is the child the spitting image of a prince or princess?
